 EXTEND THE INTERNET TO COMMUNITIES THAT DO NOT HAVE IT AND NEED IT MOST

PROMOTE the Internet

- PROMOTE THE INTERNET MODEL OF NETWORKING AS THE PREFERRED MODEL
- CONVINCE KEY GOVERNMENTS OF THE WORLD TO ADOPT POLICIES THAT FAVOR THE INTERNET MODEL AND IMPROVE INTERNET CONNECTIVITY
- PROMOTE THE DEPLOYMENT OF TECHNOLOGIES AND PROTOCOLS THAT SECURE THE INTERCONNECTION OF INDEPENDENT NETWORKS

• Shape the policies of key governments in favor of the growth of independent networks, which are free to interconnect

This plan is all about the tangible work we can do to make the Internet bigger and stronger.


By positioning the Internet Society as the place where 'stuff gets done' for the Internet, we will

- be able to exert a stronger influence on the Internet













Extending encryption

Addressing the threat to encrypted communications posed by both governments and private sector

- Develop of a narrative that advances end-to-end encryption against threats such as exceptional access
- Create a diverse and engaged global network of coalitions, with aligned participants









Increasing time security

It's time to stand up for a fundamental building block of the Internet's operation


- Develop materials to help others in their deployments
- Establish metrics to track the future deployment of time protocols

Leading by example with open standards and protocols

An opportunity to show the way in open standards. A chance to practice what we preach.

- Deploy four reference servers
- Develop easy-to-understand materials to support wider standards adoption
- Provide links to testing tools and further details on standards

- Support creation of five new IXPs and strengthen 10 in existence to support local Internet growth
- Training in key geographies
- Sow the seeds for self-sustaining communities

- Create and launch of a Web-based dashboard for public consumption
- Increase awareness of the Internet model through promotion of the dashboard

A new structure for a new direction


In 2020, we will reorganize ourselves with the goal of
